- 2. The US House has 435 seats total that are divided between the 50 states based on their population size.
- 3. US Senators are voted for every 6 years, while US Representatives are voted on every 2 years.
- 4. US Congress write and votes on nationwide legislation to provide the laws of our country.
- 5. To become a Senator you must be at least 30 years old, have been a citizen of the U.S. for the last 9 years, and must be a resident of the state that you represent.
- 6. Becoming a House Representative requires the same things, except you only have to be 25 years old!
- 7. The United States Vice-President also serves as President of the Senate.
- 8. The Speaker of the House is the leader of the House of Representatives.
- 9. The United States Congress is split up into a bicameral (2 part) system: US Senate and US House of Representatives.
